The program both identifies us with broader social circles as well as inviting conversation about our owns views, and it lets us be the critic. What Gogglebox proves is that, given a chance, human nature isn't all that bad. Its stars are not the kind you will find on proper reality television. Instead of showing us as shallow and individualistic, it tells us that what's important is watching stupid television with your best friends or family. Gogglebox shows us the reality of our viewing habits in a social expanding medium. Unlike other reality shows it doesn't feature contestants competing for screen time, it has a quick editorial turnaround.
